REPORT OF THE EXPENDITURES COMMITTEE TO GENERAL SYNOD 2025

The Expenditures Committee has had referred to it several motions for review because each of them could result in a new expenditure. Rule of Order 13(d) requires that such a motion be reviewed to determine if the funds proposed to be spent is available or, if not, what steps should be taken to provide the funds should the motion be adopted.

The following are the committee's findings with regard to these motions.

A020: The Expenditures Committee is aware that there is an amending motion which refers the potential expenditure to CoGS for budgeting purposes. The Expenditures Committee has no concerns about this.

A161: There is no quantified request for funds in this motion. Therefore, the Expenditures Committee cannot assess its budgetary implications.

A180: The budgetary implications of this motion are now subsumed under Resolution A020.

B001: The Expenditures Committee is of the view that this motion is effectively a referral to CoGS to consider the funding of the Council of the North as part of its future budgeting process, and does not seek a specific amount of money. As such, the Expenditures Committee has no financial concern about this motion.
